Overview of Agricultural Producer Security Program

- **■** Four Separate Licenses:
 - Grain Dealer
 - Grain Warehouse Keeper
 - Milk Contractor
 - Vegetable Contractor
- Goal: Protect producers from financial default
- Agricultural Producer Security Fund

Grain Dealer and Warehouse

Regulations to help prevent defaults from occurring:

- Annual license
- Balance sheet requirements
- Records and documentation
- Periodic reviews
- Fund coverage

✓ Monthly storage report

✓ "Notice to Depositors"

- ✓ Are they licensed?

- ✓ Payment terms
- ✓ Discount schedule
- ✓ "Notice to Producers"

Default Claims

What do I do if I don't get paid?

- Talk to the elevator
- Call DATCP (608)224-4968
- Filing a claim 30 days
- DATCP "Recovery Proceeding"
 - Audit claims
 - Propose settlement
 - Administrative law judge order
 - Seek reimbursement

Now Some Quick Facts

- Current Fund balance covers 3 times largest grain default in state history
- = \$3 billion in grain purchased
- 110 million bushel licensed capacity
