WDNR Runoff Management Section

Storm Water Program

 Regulates storm water discharges from construction sites, industrial facilities and municipalities.

Nonpoint Source Program

 Research, monitoring, data assessment and management, regulation and enforcement, financial and technical assistance, education and outreach and public involvement.

CAFO Program*

 Regulates farms designated as a Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) under the U.S. EPA Clean Water Act's pollutant discharge permit program.

CAFO Program

- State issues permits to:
 - Farms with 1,000+ Animal Units (AUs)
 - Farms less than 1,000 AUs that discharge to surface or groundwater.
- Permitted farm types include: dairy, beef, turkey, duck, chicken (broilers & layers), swine, sheep, and others.







CAFO Program

- Each CAFO is issued a 5
 year Wisconsin Pollutant
 Discharge Elimination
 System (WPDES) Permit
 by the WDNR.
 - Production site zero discharge
 - Land application sites –
 managed with a nutrient management plan per NRCS 590 & NR 243.14.



CAFO's in Wisconsin


- December 2015
 - 279 current WPDES permits (issued)
 - 40 new WPDES permit applications
 - **319** total
- December 2014
 - 264 current WPDES permits (issued)
 - 40 new WPDES permit applications
 - 304 total
- April 2013
 - 246 current WPDES permits (issued)
 - 24 new WPDES permit applications
 - 270 total
- April 2013 to December 2015
 - 13% growth of WPDES permitted CAFOs
 - 67% growth in new WPDES permit applications
 - 18% growth in total permits (issued & new)


